ERINDALE LIONS LITTLE LEAGUE LEVEL OF PLAY BY AGE

4/5-year-old girls/boys - <u>JUNIOR T-BALL</u> Focuses on building FUNdamental game skills such as catching, throwing, hitting, batting and running, all through fun practice sessions and short games. Teams will play once a week. Game nights will be on Tuesday nights.

5/6-year-old girls/boys - <u>Senior T-BALL</u> This division is designed to further enhance and accelerate baseball skills, making the game more enjoyable for everyone. 5-year-olds must have experience. All Sr. T-ball teams will play one game a week, and have one other night a week where they will rotate through a 4-week cycle of; practice (shared field), practice (shared field), batting cage, off-week. Monday and Wednesday nights weekly.

7/8-year-olds - Rookie Ball - This division serves as an exciting introduction to the next level of baseball. Players and parents can expect a fun and supportive environment where foundational skills are honed, and teamwork is emphasized. Gameplay for the season will progress from games where players are batting off a tee as well as being introduced to hitting off of the pitching machine, to later in the season where a more standard "Rookie Ball" game is played in which tees are no longer used, and the entire game is pitching machine. Teams will play twice a week and practice once per week.

9-13-year-olds <u>Minor/Major</u> - Based on evaluations and in consultation with parents, all players eligible for official Little League play will be assessed and placed at the level of play most appropriate for their developmental level, with our objective being that all 9-10 y/o players would play at the Minor level, with 11-13 y/o playing at the Major level. Please note that exceptions to player placements will be made in extenuating situations. Teams will have 2 games per week and 1 practice per week.

For the 2025 season, player evaluations will be required for ALL divisions except T-ball. These evaluations will take place in May to ensure each child is placed at the appropriate level of play. Please note that division structures and game schedules are subject to change based on registration numbers and evaluation results. In such cases, refund requests will be considered individually.

4-22-<u>Challenger League</u> - Adaptive, introductory T-ball program ideal for individuals ages 4 to 22 living with physical and/or cognitive disabilities. Games are held on Thursday from 6:15 to 7:45pm at Springfield park. Players will be provided a uniform (jersey and hat) and equipment will be provided for the game. Players will need their own helmet.

Evaluations for the 2025 Season

All players are to be at the park at least 15 minutes prior to the start time, dressed appropriately for the weather, a <u>GLOVE</u> and appropriate footwear.

Evaluations will take place on the field in a Spring training format, where players have the opportunity to re-engage in baseball activities through various drills and skill challenges, under the assessment of Erindale coaches. Attendance at evaluations is mandatory for all players in Rookie ball, Minor and Major divisions, as these assessments will determine team compositions. In the event of a rainouts, evaluations will be rescheduled. Team assignments will occur in the week following evaluations, utilizing a "draft" format that allows coaches to select players for the 2025 season. Practices may be held before games start. Uniforms will be provided prior to opening day.
