T- BALL

Junior T-Ball

For ages 4-5. Focus is on building the FUNdemental game skills. No prior experience is necessary. Teams will play a game Tuesday evenings with a short practice held before the game.

Senior T-Ball

For ages 5-6. Focus is on further enhancing baseball skills. 5 year olds must have prior experience. Teams will meet Monday & Wednesday evenings for a game or practice. Practices will rotate on a 4 week schedule of: practice (shared field), practice (shared field), batting cage, and an off-week.

ROOKIE BALL

For ages 7-8. This division introduces players to hitting balls from a pitching machine. Teams will play games on Tuesday and Thursday evenings with an additional day each week for practice.

MINOR

For ages 9 - 10. Player pitching begins. Teams will play games on Monday and Wednesday evenings with an additional day scheduled each week for practice.



For ages 11-12. Most games are played exclusively at the Erindale Little League Main Field. Teams play on Tuesday and Thursday evenings, including some later night games with an additional day each week for practice.

CHALLENGER

For ages 4-22. An adaptive program of T-Ball for individuals with physical and/or cognitive disabilities.

Teams will play on Thursday evenings. Participants must provide their own helmet.

*Player evaluations (in May) and parent consultations are required by all divisions except T-Ball.
















Please arrive 15 minutes prior to the start time, and dress appropriately for the weather. Please bring a GLOVE, appropriate shoes and a batting helmet.

Evaluations take place in a spring training format. Skills are assessed using various drills and skill challenges by Erindale coaches. Attendance is mandatory for all players in Rookie Ball, Minor and Major divisions as this helps establish evenly skilled teams.

In the event of a rainout, evaluations will be rescheduled. Team assignments take place the following week using a "draft" format.

All players must provide their own safety-approved batting helmet and a glove.

> Baseball cleats and a cup are highly recommended for Rookie, Minor and Major divisions.

Uniforms (cap, shirt, belt, pants, and socks) will be provided by Erindale Little League before opening day.

T-Ball & Challenger will receive cap and shirt only


If you plan to purchase a bat, please note




