Here's what you need to know:

Erindale Little League is totally run by a dedicated team of volunteers, from Coaches up to Board Members. Without volunteers, especially for coaches, we cannot field a team. If you can spare the time, please consider joining our baseball community. Just like with players, experience/knowledge would be an asset, but is not necessary at any level.



GAME DAYS & TIMES

Jr. T-Ball players (aged 4 & 5* by Aug 31st of this year) will play a combined practice & game:
Tuesday- starting at 6:15pm lasting 60-75 minutes

Sr. T-Ball players (aged 5* & 6 by Aug 31st of this year) will play a combined practice & game:
Monday & Wednesday - starting at 6:15pm lasting 60 - 90 minutes.

*5-year-olds with no experience should be registered for Junior T-ball.

*5 year olds with experience should be registered for Senior T-Ball.

Based on registration numbers and evaluations, the league may change the division and/or evenings played. In this scenario, refunds will be decided on a case-by-case basis.

EQUIPMENT - SUPPLY OR BUY?



Jr. and Sr. T-Ball Division players will be supplied a team jersey, and hat.

The following equipment is required:

- Players must have their own batting helmet.
- Players must have their own baseball glove.
- Sneakers are perfectly acceptable footwear for T-ball.
- For health and safety reasons all players **MUST** wear pants.

The following equipment is optional:

- T-Ball players usually use a team bat. However, if you choose to purchase a bat, it must bear the approved  label.

Baseball gloves and helmets can be purchased from: Home Run Sports*, SportChek, Canadian Tire, Team Town Sports, Corbett and Play it Again Sports.

PRACTICES & SKILL DEVELOPMENT



Erindale Little League uses The Little League "Teaching for Tomorrow - Learning the Game" Program for both T-ball levels.

The Junior T-Ball division serves as an exciting introduction to baseball. Players can expect a fun and supportive environment where foundational skills are taught, teamwork is emphasized and a love for the game is developed.

The Senior T-Ball division will build and reinforce skills learned in Junior T-ball.

Depending on the number of teams/diamonds available, Sr. T-Ball may occasionally not play twice a week; but will still play 20 games/season or more.
